#### **Breast Ultrasound for Breast Lump: Purpose, Procedure, Results**

Ultrasound is a painless procedure that uses sound waves to make images of the inside of your body The sound waves bounce off surfaces in your body, and the "echoes" are recorded and transformed

#### **Ultrasound - Breast**

Ultrasound - Breast Ultrasound imaging of the breast uses sound waves to produce pictures of the internal structures of the breast It is primarily used to help diagnose breast lumps or other abnormalities your doctor may have found during a physical exam, mammogram or breast MRI

Ultrasound is safe, noninvasive and does not use radiation

The male breast Gynecomastia- Best diagnosed on Mammogram Right behind nipple, usually flame shaped no calcs, may be symmetric or unilateral Malignancy- IDC, 1% of all breast cancers Any mass not directly behind the nipple must be evaluated with ultrasound +/-biopsy

some common modifiers related to the use of ultrasound for breast procedures 26 - Professional Component A physician who performs the interpretation of an ultrasound exam in the hospital outpatient setting may submit a charge for the professional component of the ultrasound service using a modifier (-26) appended to the ultrasound code

**ACR Practice Parameter for the Performance of a Breast ...**

Breast ultrasound should be performed with a high-resolution scanner and transducer (see section VII) Gain settings, focal zone selections, and field of view should be optimized to obtain high-quality images The patient should be positioned to minimize the thickness of the portion of the breast being evaluated

**Health Insurance Breast Ultrasound Law in Connecticut**

Under state law, benefits payable for breast screening services, which include mammograms, magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), and ultrasounds, are subject to any policy provisions applying to other covered services, except a policy cannot impose a copayment of more than \$20 for a breast ultrasound screening
