HMS Sheffield was the first British vessel sunk during the conflict It caught fire when an Exocet missile penetrated deep into the control room The blaze generated poisonous smoke and most of the crew abandoned ship Although Sheffield was widely reported to have an aluminium superstructure she was an all steel ship with both a steel hull
