"SCRAMBLE FOR AFRICA"? The process of the invasion, occupation, and domination of African territory by European powers from 1880-1914 (the start of World War I) In about 1880, Europeans only controlled 10% of the continent of Africa In 1913, at the end of "Scramble for Africa," (only 33 years later) Europe controlled ALMOST ALL of Africa
